
WHAT ARE WE?

Optional subjects will be granted on the basis of merit and availability of seats. An offer will be made at the personal interview with the Vice Principal / Interview Panel.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Eligibility Criteria

- ✓ Students must have passed the Class 10 (SSC) examination from the Maharashtra State Board or an equivalent board.
- ✓ Students from other boards (CBSE, ICSE, etc.) may require an eligibility certificate from the Maharashtra State Board.

2. Online Registration and Application

The admission process is conducted online through the official website:

<u>Ilthadmission.org.in</u>. The process consists of two parts:

- A. Part 1 Registration
- Register on the website and create a login ID.
- ✓ Fill in personal details and upload necessary documents.
- ✓ Pay the application fee online.
- B. Part 2 Preference Filling
- ☑ Select and fill in preferred colleges and streams (Science, Commerce, or Arts).
- ✓ Preferences can be modified before final submission.

3. Centralized Admission Process (CAP)

- Admissions are conducted through a centralized process managed by the School Education and Sports Department (SESD), Government of Maharashtra.
- Seat allocation is based on merit and preferences submitted by candidates.
- Multiple rounds of CAP are conducted to fill available seats.

4. Required Documents

Students must submit the following documents during admission:

- 🖈 Original SSC Mark Sheet and attested photocopies.
- ★ Original School Leaving Certificate and attested photocopies.
- Caste Certificate (if applicable, for reserved category candidates).
- ★ Other documents as per the official guidelines.

CRITIERIA FOR GRANTING TERMS AND FOR PROMOTION

Students of **F.Y.J.C. (Commerce and Science)** will not be promoted to S.Y.J.C. unless they fulfill the following conditions:

1.Attend at least 75% of the lectures, practical and tutorials in each term. If they do not fulfill this requirement, they will not be allowed to attempt the XI final exam.

- 2.Get their journals (in whichever subject Practical is held) certified by the concerned teacher.
- 3.Secure a minimum of 35 % on the average marks of the 1st and 2nd Exams together with the Unit Tests in each subject.
- 4.Students, who cannot attempt the 1st or 2nd term exams on medical grounds or for genuine reasons which have been accepted by the Principal / Vice-Principal, will have to appear for the Supplementary Exams.
- 5.The date and timings of the Supplementary Exams will be announced on the Junior College Notice Board.
- 6.No Supplementary Unit Tests will be held for Std. XI Students.

Students of S.Y.J.C. (Commerce and Science) as per the rules of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education:

1.It mandatory for the child to fulfill 75 % attendance of the lectures, practical and tutorials in each term. Failing to do so shall be liable for cancellation of candidate for HSC Board Exams held in Feb/March

- 2.Submit their EVS & other subjects Journal and projects as per the rules, otherwise marks for the same will not be granted by the college.
- 3.Those students who fail to submit or appear practical & other submission during board exam schedule shall be marked ABSENT in the report to be submitted to Mumbai Divisional Board.

Absence for Medical or other Valid Reasons:

- No student is allowed to remain absent from lectures, practical, unit test or terminal examinations without the explicit permission of the Principal (through the Vice Principal). If a student is absent without such permission, disciplinary action (including denial of Terms) will be initiated by the College. Absence from any College Test / Examination must be justified in writing and in case of illness, by
- a Medical Certificate. These letters and Medical Certificates, accompanied by a covering letter from the Parent / Guardian of the student, must be submitted to the Vice-Principal by the last day of the Examination / Test. Letters and Certificates to explain absence from Examinations / Tests must be submitted separately from those intended to explain absence from lectures / practical. Although illness or other serious circumstances may be considered valid reasons for absence
- from lectures, practical, examinations, unit test or terminal examinations, the College may not have sufficient evidence of academic progress to grant the student terms for the year. The student would then have to repeat the course of studies in the following academic year.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

(a) Discipline

- ★ Students must abide by the general rules of discipline laid down by the college authorities
 from time to time.
- 🖈 In all matters, the Principal's decision shall be final and binding on all students.

(b) Identity Card

- ✓ Students must always carry their Identity Card issued by the college.
- ✓ They must produce it whenever asked by the authorities.
- ✓ Students are required to display their Identity Cards visibly while on the college premises.

(c) Attendance

- ✓ Students must maintain at least the minimum attendance as prescribed by MSESHSE, Pune during each academic term.
- ✓ Students must complete tutorials, exercises, tests, and practicals as per the college guidelines to the satisfaction of the Principal.
- Students failing to meet the minimum attendance may be detained and not allowed to appear for examinations.

(d) Parking of Vehicles

- Students must obtain prior permission from the college authorities before parking their two-wheelers on campus.
 - All students must possess valid documents for their vehicles, including a Driving License.
 - Four-wheelers are not allowed to be parked on the college campus.
 - The college will not be responsible for any loss or damage to parked vehicles.
 - Parking of vehicles shall be at the owner's risk.

(e) Cleanliness of the Campus

- Every student must actively contribute to maintaining cleanliness on campus.
- ✓ Students must avoid any act that may make the campus unclean.

(f) Use of Mobile Phones

- The use of mobile phones on college premises is strictly prohibited.
- Students will be responsible for any loss or damage to their mobile phones or other valuables on campus.

MAINTENANCE OF DISCIPLINE AND GOOD CONDUCT -BY STUDENTS

Malpractices During Examinations

- According to the judicial law of the Maharashtra Government, resorting to malpractices such as copying or cheating during college examinations or H.S.C. Board Examinations is a cognizable criminal offense.
- All cases of malpractices are dealt with by a special committee appointed by the college. The decisions of the committee and the college management shall be final and binding on all students and parents.

General Conduct & Discipline

- ✓ Dress Code: Students must be properly dressed while on the college premises.
- ✓ Identity Card: Students must always display their Identity Card and produce it whenever asked by the authorities.
- ✓ Loitering: Students must avoid loitering in the porch, corridors, running in hallways, or making noise near classrooms.
- ✓ Movement in Campus: Students must always keep to the left in the corridors and staircases.

Attendance & Academic Requirements

- ★ Students must maintain minimum attendance of 75% as prescribed
 by the HSC Board each term.
- Students must complete all coursework, tutorials, tests, and practicals as required by the college and the HSC Board.
- ★ Science students missing more than 2 practical sessions will be considered defaulters.

Student Guidance & Support

- ✓ In a large college like ours, it is difficult for the Principal or Vice-Principals to attend to each student individually.
- ✓ However, students are encouraged to approach them whenever needed.
- ✓ Class Representatives (CRs) are appointed from the teaching faculty for each class.
- ✓ Students should approach their CRs for assistance in studies, extracurricular activities, or any other concerns.

Code of Conduct for Students

Every student of Gnyanodaya Junior College shall always:

- Conduct themselves properly.
- ✓ Maintain appropriate behavior.
- Observe strict discipline both inside and outside the college, including public places like buses, trains, picnics, educational trips, and playgrounds.
- Ensure that no action of theirs brings disrepute to the college.
- Not lodge complaints or make representations regarding any college matters to the press or external agencies without forwarding the same through the Principal. Acts of Misconduct and Indiscipline

The following actions will be considered as misconduct and indiscipline:

- X Disrupting the lawful functioning of the college.
- X Habitual unpunctuality in attending lectures, practicals, tutorials, and other courses.
- X Repeated absence from classes, tutorials, and practical sessions.
- X Raising funds or collecting donations without prior approval from the Principal.
- X Securing admission through fabrication or suppression of information.
- X Disturbing other students during classroom or extracurricular activities.
- X Possessing or using weapons, explosives, or harmful substances on campus.
- × Possessing or consuming intoxicants (such as tobacco, drugs, narcotics, gutkha, pan masala, or alcohol).
- X Smoking is strictly prohibited on campus.
- × Ragging, bullying, or harassing any student or college staff member.
- X Engaging in violence, assault, or threats within or outside the college.
- X Destroying or tampering with official records or documents.
- X Skipping college events, meetings, or cultural/sports activities without valid reasons.
